Maths	<p>Counting to 4 – point to each item as you count, then count 4 objects that cannot be moved. Show 4 on fingers. Watch the corresponding numberblocks episode, on BBC iPlayer or YouTube</p>	<p>Representing 4 – how many things can you count 4 of? Claps, fingers, toys, cups, count 4 of as many things from around your house as possible. Have a go at drawing 4 too.</p>	<p>Writing 4 – use chalk, sand, glitter, playdough to practise writing the number 4 before you use a pencil and write it on paper.</p>	<p>Finding 4 – go on a number hunt around your house to find the number 4. How many times can you see it?</p>	<p>Making 4 – how many different ways can you make the number 4? Eg 1 + 3 5 – 1 What is 1 more than 4 and 1 less than 4? How many different ways can I share out 4?</p>
